- You are responsible for your own transportation to Salt Lake City
- The IRS requires participants must be a member of OCCGS - see membership flyer for dues
- No reductions for fewer days stay at the hotel.
- Final payment is due by **March 4, 2017**.
- All checks must be made payable to **OCCGS**.
- When rooms are filled, a \$100 deposit will put you on a standby list.
- Individual cancellations must be received by the March 4, 2017 meeting.
- Refunds for cancellations made following that date are based upon hotel refund policy, plus a \$50.00 handling charge for OCCGS.
- OCCGS is not liable for personal sickness or injury, or loss or damage to personal property.

Room Differences:

- A **deluxe** room is a little larger than the **standard** room and the **deluxe** rooms are on the 'front' side of the hotel. The **deluxe** room has 2 sinks where the **standard** room has only 1 sink. All **standard** rooms are on the 'back' side of the hotel. If you require a handicap room you must request a **deluxe** room as there are no standard rooms that are handicap compatible.
