Enlisted 13 August 1862 at the age of 54 for a period of 3 years. Commissioned 22 August 1862 and resigned 25 January 1863 by reason of physical disability.

Was a Minister of the Methodist Episcopal Church for forty years

Came to California about 1883 and resided in Orange.

Harrison's son, Wesley F Adams, fought with Co F & S, Ohio 18th Infantry Regiment as a Comm. Sergeant and was discharged due to disability 20 December 1862

Harrison's son, Leonidas H Adams, fought in Spanish American War, with Co D, 35th US INF.
