Additional Information

Albert N. Alderman was the oldest son Elura Cook and Jesse M. Alderman a veteran of the war of 1812 born in Granby, Connecticut. His wife is also a native of Granby. The family moved to Ashtabula County, Ohio where they owned a farm and Jesse also worked as a millwright. Albert Alderman apprenticed as a carpenter and then studied bookkeeping obtaining a job with a shipping company.

Albert offered his services to the military early in 1861 for a three-month period, but the quota was filled. In August of 1861 he was accepted as a private in Co K, 29th Ohio Infantry. He saw action at Cedar Mountain, Antietam, Lookout Mountain, Chickamauga and other battles ending with the siege of Atlanta. Following in their father's footsteps five of Albert's brothers also joined the ranks of the military during the Civil War. Reuben W. also in the 29th, Addison in the 87th Ohio Infantry, Phares 4th Battalion, Ohio Infantry, William H. 8th Regiment, Ohio Infantry, and Demetrius F. 177th Regiment, Ohio Infantry. All of them appeared to have survived the war.

Albert and his wife, Elizabeth Brennan, left Ohio and eventually found their way to California. In the 1880 census they are living Tustin, Orange County, California with four of their children, Lillian, Heber, Alton and Ray (Arlington). In the 1890 Voter Registration records he lists his occupation as Carpenter. Elizabeth passes away in 1887. Albert is found living with his daughter Lillian Elizabeth Alderman Sheats and her family in the 1900 census.

Albert N. Alderman was a member of Sedgwick Post No 17 of the GAR.
