Samuel Armour's book "*History of Orange County*" published in 1921 includes a biographical sketch on Milo Bailey that provides information on his parents Lucien Allen and Rhoda Conklin. Milo's father was born in Erie County, Ohio and is a descendant of Ethan Allen of Revolutionary fame. Lucien is also known to have taken the lead in developing wheat cultivation in Minnesota. Armour also mentions Lucien's four years with the Third Minnesota Volunteers as a fifer during the Civil War and that he continued this love of music by playing in military bands during patriotic events.
