George L Anderson, age 20, enlisted as a Private on 14 August 1862 with Co C, 126th Infantry Ohio. He Mustered In on 4 September 1862 and Mustered Out on 25 June 1865 at Washington D.C.

George L Anderson practiced Allopathic Medicine. He attended Starling Medical College in Columbus, Ohio. He practiced in Newkirk, Kay County, Oklahoma and in Santa Ana, Orange County, California.
