**The 150th Regiment**, Illinois Infantry was organized at Camp Butler, Illinois, and mustered in for 1 year's service February 14, 1865. It mustered out January 16, 1866. Company E had many men from Vermillion County, Illinois. The residence George Barnett was listed as Indianola. He was mustered in February 6, 1865, and mustered out January 16, 1866, when the unit was disbanded.
