Comments

No definite census records were found for Daniel Bartlett in 1850 or 1860. While an 1860 Census record was found for Bremer County, Iowa the same county Daniel was married in 1869, the family he was living with was Byram but a connection to Daniel F. Bartlett who married Dameries Payton was not determined.

An 1856 Iowa Census for Chickasaw County also lists a Daniel F. Bartlett born in Illinois but the family he is living with is Geddes. No connection could be made with this family and Daniel F. Bartlett who married Demarias Payton.

Several family trees list his parents as Joel Bartlett and Juliana Felkey. Joel Bartlett is listed as being born in Illinois and Juliana in Iowa. This contradicts the birth states of Daniel F. Bartlett’s parents listed in the 1880, 1900 and 1910 census of Vermont and Ohio respectively.
