Enlisted as a Private in Company C, Sixth Minnesota Infantry on 16 February 1864 at Fairmont, Martin County, Minnesota, mustered out 19 August 1865 at Fort Snelling, Minnesota

Prior to leaving for duty he married Lydia Jane Swearingen-Allen in what was called a "large military celebration".

Named first County Commissioner of Martin County, Minnesota
