William Hampton Budd - - Pioneer, Soldier and Community Builder

The Martin County Historical Society has a Biography of William H. Budd on their website <http://www.fairmont.org/mchs/William%20Hampton%20Budd.pdf>. The following is a brief excerpt.

He was one of the original settlers of Martin County and published a book, *Martin County Before 1880*, about the early history of Martin County based upon his personal experiences. At one point Mr. Budd was the assistant overseer of the Winnebago Indian Agency which was near Mankato. He settled in the area and acted as a guide for people who were looking to settle there. He was one of the first county commissioners in 1857 and was the postmaster of Fairmont, the county seat.

In early 1864 Mr. Budd enlisted in Company C, Sixth Minnesota Infantry. Prior to leaving he married Lydia Jane Swearingen-Allen in what was called a "large military celebration".
