Additional Information

Daniel Clark was the son of Michael Clark and Larissa/Teresa Unknown. His siblings were James, Margaret, Mary, Theresa, Timothy, and Catherine. His father was from Ireland, and his mother was from either Canada or Ireland.

Daniel Clark enlisted on 5 January 1864 at Springfield, Wisconsin into Company E of the 22nd Wisconsin Infantry Regiment as a Private. He transferred into the 3rd Wisconsin Infantry on 10 June 1865. The 22nd Wisconsin Infantry was attached to the Army of the Cumberland in 1864 to 1865. He mustered out on 18 July 1865 at Louisville, Kentucky.

Daniel Clark applied for a pension on 28 July 1890 and again on 27 February 1900 with Application Number 787,462 and Certificate Number 1,031,903. The pension gives his death date as 12 December 1931.

Daniel Clark married Addie C. Dickey in 1878 in Rock County, Wisconsin, and was in Iowa in the 1880 Census, where his children were born. In the 1900 Census his wife gave her number of children as 6 children, but 5 only were living. The sixth child is unknown. It is unknown if any of his daughters were married, or where they died.

Daniel Clark was admitted to Sawtelle Soldiers Home in Los Angeles on 5 February 1912, and discharged on 14 April 1913. His nearest relative was listed as Frank S. Clark of Kalispell, Montana.

In the 1910 Census, his wife Addie stated she was a widow, but the 1920 Census she stated she was divorced. The Census indicate that Addie never lived in California, but Daniel was in the Soldiers Home in 1912, and is buried in Orange County, California, while his wife died in Washington, and was buried in Wisconsin with her parents. The

above info seems to indicate they were indeed divorced. Daniel Clark could not be found in the 1910 Census.
