Funeral services for Mrs. Emma Cleveland, Civil War widow were held in the chapel Monday Afternoon. Chaplain E. B. Earle officiated. Mrs. Cleveland had been an invalid since 1938, when she fell and broke a leg. She had been a member of the Home for many years, coming here with her husband, who later died when they were visiting in California. Mrs. Cleveland was born in Cleveland, Ohio, July 20, 1846. An adopted daughter, Mrs. Grace C. Nichols of Los Angeles, Calif. survives.
