Byron Coe, age 18, born in New York, 5' 7" with grey eyes and auburn hair was a farmer residing in Geneseo, Henry County, Illinois when he enlisted as a Private in Co I, 112th US Infantry for a period of 3 years.

Muster In on March 30, 1864 at Springfield Illinois.

Transferred to 65th Infantry on June 15, 1865

Muster In on April 25, 1864 as a Private in Co F, 65th IL US INF CON at Camp Butler, Illinois

Muster Out on July 13, 1865 at Greensboro, North Carolina
