Military Service

Asa E. Coleman was 23 when he enlisted. His residence was Big Mound, and was born in Ohio. He enlisted on 23 August 1861 and mustered in 30 August 301861. He was promoted Eighth Corporal 25 April 1863, and Seventh Corporal 20 May 1863, and was wounded 25 May 1863 at Pope's Farm, Arkansas. He was promoted Sixth Corporal 1 October 1863, and discharged 24 April 1864.

United States, Civil War and Later Pension Files

Asa E. Coleman filed on 7 November 1865 and 7 February 1908 for an invalid pension

Mary, his widow, filed for a widow's pension on 6 May 1921.

His date of death was listed as 6 April, 1921, at Walnut Park, California.

Mary C. Coleman authored two books, one about the history of Washington County, Kansas, and the other about Shields family genealogy. She is buried in the Hollenberg City Cemetery, Washington County, Kansas along with her parents, Richard E. Derrick, and Ruth J. Elliott.

Asa and Mary married on 12 March 1872. The 1895 Kansas State Census showed Dorr age 5 and Claude Coleman age 1 living with them. The 1900 US Census lists the boys as nephews Dorr Mora age 10 and Claude F Mora age 7. The 1905 Kansas State Census lists D. M Morey age 15 and Claude F Morey age 11 "helping on the farm." The 1910 US Census, Manhattan, Riley, Kansas lists them as Nephews Dorr Morey, 20 and Claude Morey, 17. The 1920 Census has Claude Morey 26, his wife Fae M Morey 24 and their son Russell Morey 3 7/12 living with Asa and Mary Coleman in Los Angeles, California. Dorr Morey is enumerated in Manhattan Township of the Riley County, Kansas State Census in 1915. Asa Coleman died in 1921, and Mary Coleman (74) is enumerated in 1930 at the Dorr Morey household in Manhattan, Riley County, Kansas.
