Data from Article:

- William Burton Crandall was Orange County's last living Civil War veteran.
- Born March 10, 1851 in Cohoes, NY; Crandall ran away to enlist as a substitute for Alonzo Marsh when Crandall was 12 years old.
- Crandall gave his age as 18 and was assigned to the 52nd New York Infantry.
- Crandall was wounded in the hand at the battle of Fredericksburg, VA and wounded in the head at the battle of Spotsylvania two weeks later.
