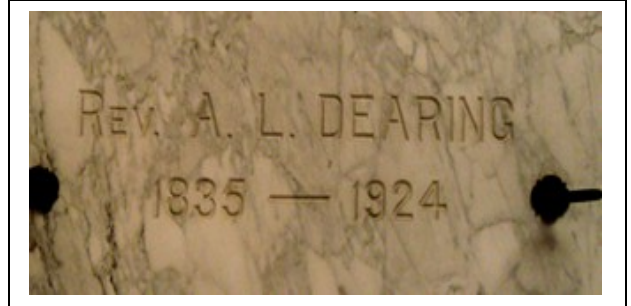

5th Main Infantry fought at the battle of Antietam 17 September 1862, Dearing was part of the ambulance corps at this battle. Albert Dearing was wounded at battle of Chancellorsville, May 1863, which ended his military career.

Albert L. Dearing was living in Webster, Maine at time of enlistment 23 June 1861. He enlisted as a Sergeant in Co G, 5th Infantry Regiment for the State of Maine. He was promoted to Full Captain on 15 June 1863 and Mustered out 15 Dec 1863.
