Samuel B. Everett, Private, Co G, 4 IL US CAF residing in Metamora, Woodford County, IL joined August 27, 1862

Transferred to Co A as consolidated

Mustered out of Co A June 5, 1865 in Memphis, TN

4th Illinois Cavalry Regiment History, Adjutant General's Report

Company A, commanded by Captain E. D. Osband, was detached to serve as escort to General U.S. Grant, in whose service it continued until August 1863.
