## Comments

The connection of William W. G. Everett to this unit is supposition only on the part of the researcher. No solid record has been established as to what side he fought on or if he was possibly a drummer boy. Other members of his family, uncles, fought for the Confederacy many in the 8<sup>th</sup> VA Cavalry. Based on documentation found by another researcher it has been assumed that he fought with a Kentucky unit. In 1860 William was living in Cabell County, Virginia subsequently West Virginia.
