## **Additional Information**

Maroni Naphtali Fuller was the son of Josiah Fuller and Catherine Laur (Warren). His siblings were John, Josiah, Benjamin W., and Sarah Fuller. Josiah Fuller was killed at the Haun's Mill massacre when at least 17 Mormon men died in an attack in eastern Caldwell County, Missouri by a mob/militia unit from Livingston County, Missouri, part of the 1838 Mormon War in Missouri. His mother remarried to William Warren.

Maroni Fuller enlisted on 19 July 1862, and mustered in on 21 August 1862 at Springville, Illinois into Company G of the 73<sup>rd</sup> Illinois Infantry Regiment as a Private. He discharged on 22 June 1865 at Quincy, Illinois. The 73<sup>rd</sup> Illinois saw service in Kentucky, Tennessee, and Georgia, with most being in Tennessee.

Maroni Fuller applied for a pension on 19 July 1865, and he lived in Sawtelle Soldiers Home in Los Angeles for about a year starting in 1925.

Maroni Fuller married three times: first to Nancy Myers Range in 1861, then to Lizzie W. Sturgeon in 1917, and finally to Jessie Frances Ogilvie (Rudd) in 1928.
