George Fuson is listed as a widower in the 1900 census. A grave at Santa Ana Cemetery listed as Mrs. G. W. Fuson, may be his wife's grave (Section: C Block: 5 Lot: 18 Space: 1) but is not located near George's grave. Also George is buried with his name spelled Fusson.

Charles Beal of the local SUV located a 1905 article in the Los Angeles Times describing George Fuson as an eccentric Civil War Veteran. An apparent connection to GAR was found in his burial records. George's death notice in the Register spells his last name as Fusson but provides little other information. There are no other Fuson or Fusson buried in Orange per current listings nor does there appear to be any connection to a few Fuson families found in other parts of California.

Census records indicate George's parents were both born in Tennessee and that his wife's father was born in Maine and her mother in Ohio. No census records prior to 1880 have been located under any spelling of the last name nor has any record of military service during the Civil War.

Current on-line cemetery records indicate 261 of 364 Fuson listings for Kentucky are from Bell County. Many of these families came from Tennessee and their name has been spelled as Fuson, Fusson and Fuston over the years.
