- Enlisted 10 November 1861, mustered in 1 December 1861, mustered out 20 June 1865

New York, Civil War Muster Roll

- Enlisted 10 November 1861 at the age of 20 at Colchester, Vermont
- Mustered in 1 December 1861 as a Private in Co E, 102nd Infantry
- Captured 6 March 1865 at Wadesboro, North Carolina
- Released Aikens Landing, Virginia 2 April 1865
- Discharged as a Corporal 20 June 1865 at Annapolis, Maryland

Milon E. Greenough and his brother Frank M. received patent number 561,375 for a butter cutter and lifter

Milon's brother John A Greenough was a Civil War Veteran and is also buried in Orange County.
