Illinois Civil War Detail Report

George Hale, 19, born in and residing at Naples Scott County, Illinois re-enlisted as a Private in Co I, 129th Illinois US Infantry on 2 August 1862 for a period of 3 years. He was single, a farmer, 5' 4" with dark hair and blue eyes. He mustered in on 8 September 1862 at Pontiac Illinois and mustered out 8 June 1865 at Washington, DC.

Saw service with W T Sherman on his March to the Sea.

Moved to California from Decatur, Illinois in 1931 with his daughter Daisy Hale Price.

Comments

Based on George W Hale's obituary which list 4 surviving children these records can be matched back to 1900 and 1910 census where is wife's name is listed as Rebecca/Rebekah born in Tennessee. The 1900 census indicates she was born about 1846, had 8 children 4 of whome are still living and had been married about 1866. The marriage data matches up with an Illinois Marriage record between a Rebecca L Braham and George Hale in Scott County Illinois and a Illinois death record for a Rebecca Brahm Hale born in Memphis Tennessee in 1847 and who died in Scott County, Illinois in 1918.

An 1880 and 1870 census for the above family was not located. A Cass County census record which lists a George W Hale born about 1845 in Illinois with children, Erwin L, Horace W., and James can be found but the wife is named Mary L and was born about 1850 in Illinois. This data has not been included because of the discrepancies in wife's name and birth dates.
