Co K, 101st Infantry Regiment - Enlisted 9 November 1861, mustered in 14 November 1861, transferred out 24 December 1862 and into Co I, 40th Infantry Regiment. Intra-company transfer to Co F, 40th Infantry Regiment on 29 May 1863, July 1864, promoted to Full Corporal 1 March 1865, mustered out 27 June 1865 at Washington D.C.

In James Guinn's 1902 book on Southern California it was reported that Robert Hotaling had 10 acres of land in the Olive Precinct on which he grew lemons and apricots.

Robert Hotaling's step-daughter Lottie Siegfried married Robert Briggs Turrill son of John Murray Turrill a Civil War Veteran buried in Orange County.
