Enlisted 28 September 1861 at Chariton, Iowa, mustered in 28 October 1861, wounded in the thigh 6 April 1862 at Shiloh, Tennessee. He was promoted to Full Sergeant 16 June 1862, promoted to Full 2nd Lieutenant 21 June 1862, and promoted to Full 1st Lieutenant 30 December 1862. He was wounded 22 July 1864 at Atlanta, Georgia, mustered out 18 December 1864 at King's Bridge, Georgia
