Illinois Civil War Detail Report

William N Jackson, single, age 23 and born in Lawrenceburg, Lawrence County, Tennessee enlisted in Co D, 22nd Illinois US Infantry on June 25, 1861 for a period of three years. He was a teamster residing Greenville, Bond County, Illinois and was 5' 11' tall with black hair and brown eyes. He mustered in 25 June 1861 at Caseyville, St Clair County, Illinois and mustered out 7 July 1864 at Springfield, Sangamon County, Illinois.
