Twenty-Ninth Infantry

Kammerer, William - Age 22 years, Enlisted November 18, 1862 at New York city, to serve Three years, mustered in as Private Co E, same date transferred to independent Company this regiment June 2, 1863 and April 19, 1864 to Co C Sixty-Eighth Infantry.

Sixty-Eighth Regiment,

Kammerer, William – Private, independent company, Twenty-Ninth Infantry; transferred to Co C this regiment April 19, 1864; discharged, November 20, 1865 at Savannah, Georgia.

George's Kammerer's wife died when his youngest was an infant. He raised his family on his own. He came to Orange County in 1900 settling in the Fullerton area.
