Illinois Civil War Detail Report

Perrine Lyon, age 30 and a native of Mars Township, Washington County, Pennsylvania and living at Lane Station, Ogle County, Illinois enlisted 12 August 1862 for a period of 3 years as a Private in Co H, 92nd Illinois US Infantry at Lane Depot, Ogle County, Illinois. Married and a joiner by trade he mustered in 4 September 1862 at Rockford, Winnebago County, Illinois. He mustered out as a Musician on 21 June 1865 at Concord, North Carolina.
