Cyrus' brother, James S. Magill, served in the 11th Wisconsin Infantry Regiment

Cyrus' daughter Peryl graduated from Los Angeles College of Osteopathic Physicians and Surgeons June 1912. She opened her first office in Santa Ana and was active with the Red Cross during World War I. She married B. Dean Clanton an attorney in Los Angeles.

Cyrus' son James W. served in the Air Corps during World War I.
