Enlisted 27 August 1861, mustered out 16 September 1864. His regiment was called the “Live Eagle Regiment” for the live eagle they carried during the units entire service in the army.

Carlos first came to California in 1868 opening a general store in Camptonville in Yuba County. He brought his family out to Orange County in 1880.

Appointed Postmaster at Campton, Yuba County, California on 11 April 1877. County Treasurer of Orange County for two terms and member of the City Board of Education.

Carlos Mansur's son, Frederick, married Minnie Gardner the stepdaughter of Civil War Veteran Albert Dearing who is buried in Orange County,

Carols Mansur is the brother-in-law of Harrison Gale a Civil War Veteran buried in Orange County. Carlos's wife, Columbia, is the sister of Harrison Gale.
