### Illinois Civil War Detail Report

John F Marquis. Born in Pennsylvania, age 21 and living in New Rutland, LaSalle County Illinois enlisted 15 October 1861 as a Bugler at New Rutland, LaSalle County, Illinois for a period of 3 years. He mustered in 31 December 1861. He reenlisted as a veteran 5 January 1864 at Natchez, Mississippi, mustered 4 March 1864. He was promoted to Sergeant, promoted to Full 2<sup>nd</sup> Lieutenant 2 November 1864, and promoted to Full 1<sup>st</sup> Lieutenant 8 January 1865. He mustered out 14 July 1865 at Chicago, Cook County, Illinois.
