Enlisted and mustered in 7 December 1864, mustered out 6 December 1865 at Mobile, Alabama. He served as chief clerk in district headquarter offices until six months prior to Lee's surrender.

Oscar Maryatt was a school teacher in Woodstock, Illinois, Ft Dodge, Iowa and Farley Iowa where he became school principal. He obtained his law degree in 1867 and worked as an attorney for the C. D. and M. Railway a position he held for 16 years. He also worked in the silver and gold mining business while in Colorado.
