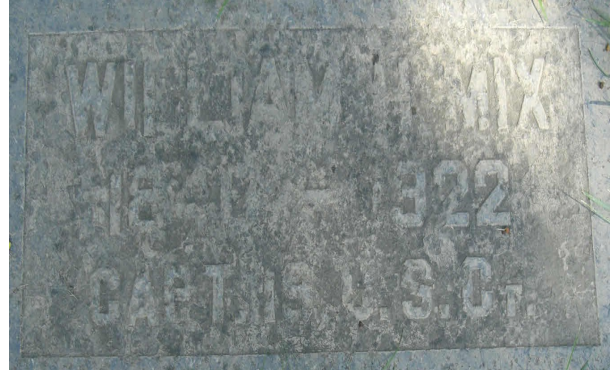

Military Service Records

William H. Mix, 23, enlisted as a Private in the 2nd New Hampshire Volunteers on 21 April 1861 serving with the unit for over two years. He was promoted to Lieutenant in the 19th Regiment, U.S. Colored Troops and mustered in at Camp Stanton, Benedict, Maryland on 9 January 1864. He mustered out 15 January 1867 at Brownsville, Texas.

William's bother, Lawrence Wesley, served during the Civil War with Co D, 12th Infantry Regiment, US Army.
