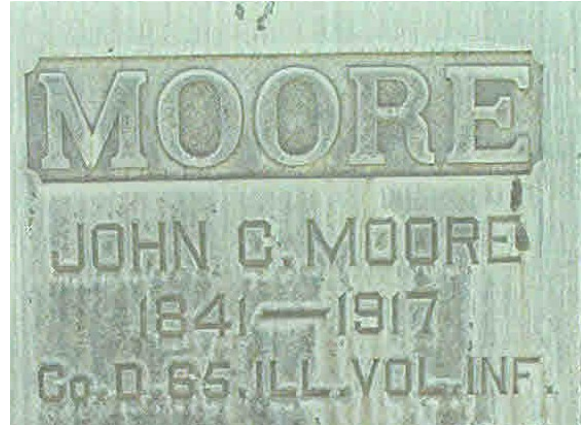

Illinois Civil War Detail Report

John C Moore, 21 and a farmer born in Ohio, enlisted as Private in Co D, 65th Illinois US Infantry on 13 March 1862 at Chicago, Cook County, Illinois for a period of 3 years. He mustered in 15 March 1862. He re-enlisted as a Veteran in Louisville, Kentucky and was transferred to Co E. He mustered out as a Sergeant on 13 July 1855 in Greensboro, North Carolina.
