George Mosbaught first enlisted with the 51st Indiana Volunteer Regiment. The unit could not raise the required quota of men so the unit never mustered in. He enlisted again 17 May 1864 with Co D, 133rd Indiana Volunterr Infantry. He mustered out 5 September 1864 at Indianapolis, Indiana

George Mosbaugh was educated as a teacher and after the Civil War became proprietor first of Terra Haute Business College in Indiana and then a business school in Bloomington, Illinois.

George Mosbaugh settled in the city of Orange, May of 1875, starting one of the early orange orchards. He was also the secretary for the Santa Ana Valley Irrigation Company and was the first bookkeeper of the Commercial Bank in Santa.

George's son Edwin was the Chief of the Redlands Fire Department and assistant Chief of the Riverside Fire Department.
