Enlisted 22 March 1862 in Company G at Platteville, Wisconsin, transferred to Company A when the regiment was reorganized 1 February 1865, mustered out 8 September 1865

David's brother William Brownwell Newcomb fought with Co C, 7th Wisconsin Infantry Volunteers. He was wounded 14 September 1862 at the battle of South Mountain, MD and died of his wounds at the US General Hospital, Frederick City, Maryland.
