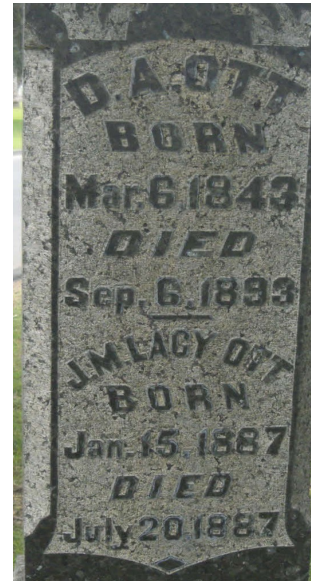

Additional Information

Enlisted in the 52nd Infantry Regiment 16 July 1861. Transferred into 2nd Rockbridge Light Artillery Regiment 28 September 1861. Wounded 1 June 1862 at the Battle of Strasburg. Records have him serving through 28 February 1865.

David had two brothers that fought in the Civil War:

James Davidson Ott, served with Co H, 14th Virginia Cavalry Regiment who is also buried in Orange County

Franklin Augustus Ott, served with Co H, 14th Virginia Cavalry Regiment
