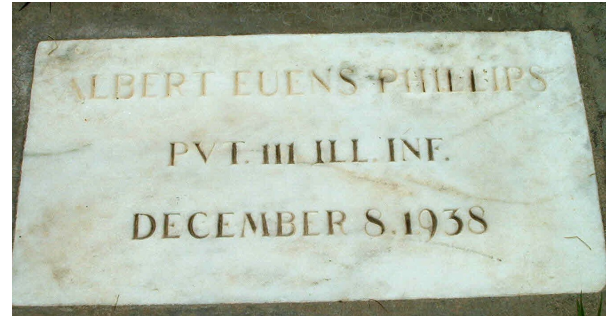

Illinois Civil War Detail Report

Albert E Phillips age 21 and a resident of Wayne County, Illinois enlisted as a Private with Co K, 111th Illinois US Infantry on 21 August 1862 at Jeffersonville, Illinois for a period of 3 years. Married and a farmer he was born in Monroe County, Ohio. He mustered in 18 September 1862 at Camp Marshall, Illinois and mustered out 7 June 1865 at Washington, DC.

Based on a 1938 Newspaper Clipping found in The Daughters of Union Veterans scrapbook (newspaper not cited on document) Albert E Philips had a brother, uncle and five cousins that fought during the Civil War. Albert's unit participated in Sherman's March to the Sea.
