Richard enlisted 18 November 1861 at Clarksville, Montgomery County, Tennessee for one year. He was underage. He was captured at Fort Donnellson on 16 February 1862. He was sent from Camp Douglas, Illinois 5 September 1862 to Vicksburg to be exchanged. He was discharged 10 March 1863 at Port Hudson, Louisiana.
