Mustered in 15 May 1861 at Germantown, Tennessee, captured near Atlanta, Georgia 22 July 1864 and sent to the Military Prison, Louisville, Kentucky, sent to Camp Chase, Ohio 30 July 1864, transferred to City Point, Virginia 25 February 1865 for exchange. Sent to 3rd Division General Hospital Camp Winder, Richmond, Virginia, admitted to Jackson Hospital, Richmond, Virginia 7 March 1865, furloughed 8 March 1865 for 30 days.

Filed for Pension 30 August 1913 at Bell County, Texas.

Received Southern Cross 3 June 1920 from Emma Sansom Chapter 449, Santa Ana
