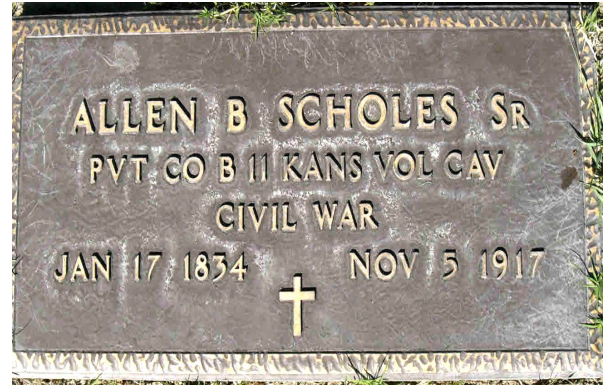

Scholes, Allen B. living in Holton enlisted as a Private in Co B, 11th Kansas Cavalry on 18 August 1862 at Jackson, Kansas , mustered in 30 August 1862, mustered out 2 June 1865.

Allen's daughter Marguerite married Joel B Crites the son of John Crites, a Civil War Veteran, also buried in Orange County.
