Additional Information

Jacob G. Shoemaker served in the 9th Regiment, Kansas Militia Infantry, which was called into service to repel Price's invasion. The unit disbanded 29 October 1864. After the Civil War, he returned to Kansas, where he remained until 1881, when he moved to California.
