Illinois Civil War Detail Report

Charles W Snure, 26, a farmer born in Canada enlisted as a Private in Co A, 12th Illinois US Cavalry on 1 November 1862 at Rockford, Winnebago County, Illinois for a period of 3 years. He mustered in 28 November 1862 at Springfield, Sangamon County, Illinois. He was transferred Co H when the units were consolidated. He mustered out 31 October 1865 at Houston, Harris County, Texas.
