Additional Information

Helen's brother John A Stebbins was with the 2nd Vermont Regiment during the Civil War. He was discharged as the result of an incurable disease and died in Baltimore, Maryland in 1863. Per T*he Stebbins Genealogy*, his mother, Eunice, went to Baltimore to nurse him. After his death his mother Eunice and his two sisters, Helen and Julia, signed on as nurses at Baltimore's Jarvis Hospital. They continued their work in Baltimore until the end of the war.
