

• Stuelke was the last surviving member of the Malvern Hill GAR Post

Enlisted 15 August 1862 and mustered out 14 August 1865. As part of Grant's unit he fought at Vicksburg and participated in Sherman's March to the Sea. Stuelke was wounded and left for dead at Tupelo, Lee County, Mississippi. He was captured by Confederate troops on 14 July 1864 and spent time at various southern prisoners including Cahaba Prison in Selma, Dallas County, Alabama before being sent to Andersonville where he spent the remainder of the war. He was exchanged 10 April 1865 at Vicksburg, Warren County, Mississippi and discharged 14 August 1865 for disability and wounds received.
