Edward Sweeny's body was found by hunters in Gypsum Canyon near Santa Ana. It is unknown exactly how he died, but the theory is that he died from exposure and lack of sustenance after leaving a mining camp and becoming lost. His remains were interred as a county charge. More details are contained in the 22 and 29 July 1909 Anaheim Gazette articles.
