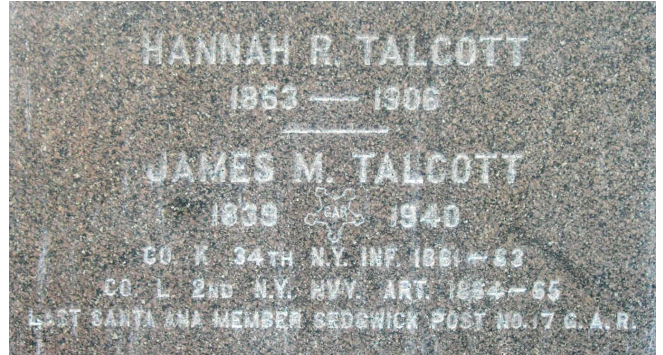

James M Talcott enlisted on 1 May 1861 at Salisbury, New York for a period of two years. He mustered in as a Private with Company K, 34th Infantry Regiment New York on 15 June 1861.

- Full Sergeant on 8 July 1862
- Full 1st Sergeant on 24 Jul 1862.

Mustered Out with the company 30 June 1863 at Albany, NY.

James M Talcott enlisted in Co L, 2nd H.A. on 7 January 1864 at Burlington, Otsego County, New York for a period of 3 years; wounded 2 June 1864 near Cold Harbor, Virginia, disability discharge 12 January 1865 at First Division Hospital, Alexandria, Virginia
