## Additional Information

Andrew B. Wallace was the son of James Wallace and Mary Jane Goldsby. His parents died in 1858 and 1853, respectively, leaving the children orphans. In the 1860 Census, some are living with his grandparents, Andrew Hampton Wallace and Catherine Newman.

Andrew B. Wallace enlisted on 24 March 1862 at Bath Alum Springs, Virginia, and was mustered out on 4 January 1864 at Hardy County, West Virginia.
