# Additional Information

William B Wetherbee, age 19, a resident of Chapin, Morgan County, Illinois enlisted 7 May 1865 for a period of 100 days. He mustered in to Co C, 145<sup>th</sup> Illinois Infantry on 9 Jun 1864 at Camp Butler, Illinois. He mustered out 23 September 1864 at Camp Butler, Illinois.

William Wetherbee's father died shortly after he was born. His mother, Julia Doan Wetherbee, married Lyman Chapin on 3 April 1849. The following year the family relocated to Morgan County, Illinois. William entered the preparatory department of Illinois College in 1858. After the war he attended Jacksonville Business College and was active in farming in the Chapin area until 1879. William and his wife moved to Wayne County, Indiana where he was a sheep farmer. In 1900 William and Mary are living with Lyman and Julia Chapin in Orange County, California.
