- Hiram W Winans, Company H, 24th Iowa Infantry
- John S Winans, Company K, 134th Ohio Infantry

David Winans and his family came to California in 1886 first settling at Elsinore. In 1888 he came to Santa Ana and worked as a carpenter. He also resided in Newport Beach for a few years.
