Enlisted in Co E, 4<sup>th</sup> State Militia Cavalry on 8 August 1863 at Savannah, Missouri, mustered in 30 October 1863 at Sedalia, Missouri, promoted to 7<sup>th</sup> Sergeant September 1863 then to 5<sup>th</sup> Sergeant May 1864 then to 1<sup>st</sup> Sergeant September 1864, transferred out March 1865. Transferred to Co B on March 1865, mustered out 5 July 1865 at Benton Barracks, Missouri
