Hanson's brother George Young also served in the 81st Illinois Infantry in the Field and Staff Company as the Principal Musician and is buried in Orange County

Hanson's brother Peter Young was a Sergeant with Co F, 63rd Illinois Infantry during the Civil War. He died 27 February 1863 in Memphis, Shelby County, Tennessee at the age of 23.

George's father George Young was bound at the age of 13 to Frederick Sheetz, to learn the trade of gunsmith. George Young became a gunsmith in his own right setting up shop in Romney, Hampshire County in what eventually became West Virginia. He made both flintlock and percussion rifles.
